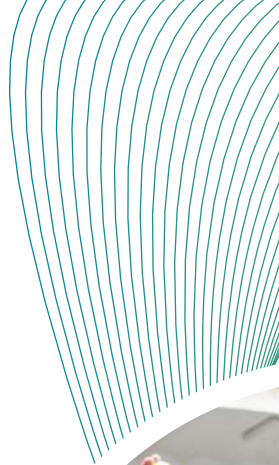

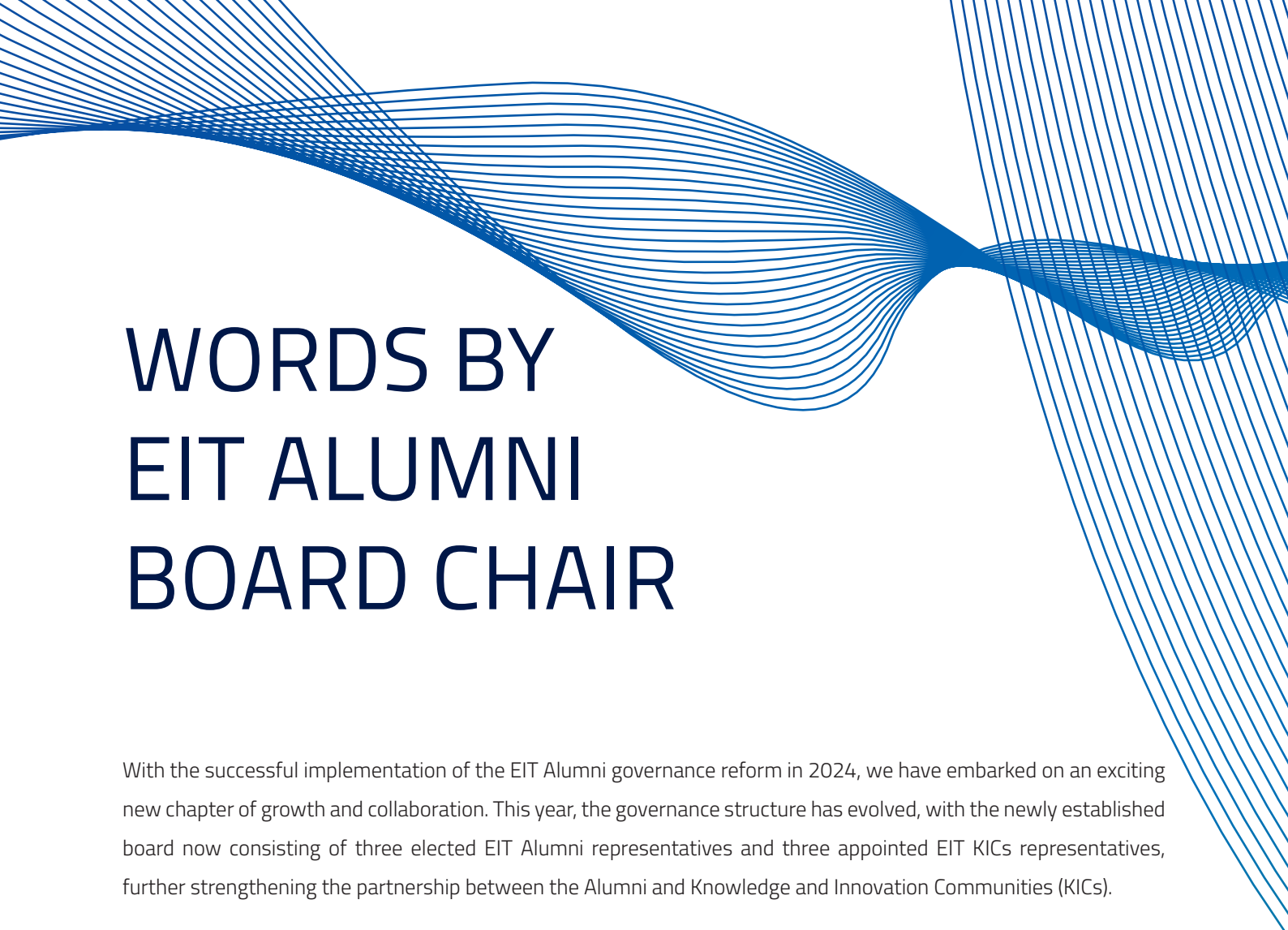
EIT ALUMNI BOARD MEMBERS

ALUMNI'S LOCAL EVENTS

In 2024, the EIT Alumni community continued its tradition of fostering connections through local events across Europe. Building on the success of previous years, local events were strategically organized in conjunction with major initiatives such as community weeks, CONNECT 2024, and cluster meetings. These gatherings offer alumni the chance to reconnect, meet EIT and KIC representatives, and forge valuable relationships. The continued success of these events highlights their importance in maintaining a vibrant and engaged alumni network throughout Europe.

The local events are open to all Alumni from all KICs and they were very successful both in terms of participation and of interest, and they involved high level speakers and participants.





VIENNA, 14 MARCH 2024

The first EIT Alumni event of 2024 took place in Vienna, bringing together alumni, local ecosystem leaders, and members of various KICs. The evening featured inspiring talks, including a keynote by EIT's Agnes Molnar and a founder-focused session with Catherine Schreiber, highlighting resilience in entrepreneurship.

A panel discussion with Alexander Diesenreiter (Impact Hub Vienna) and Nina Hödlmayrand (Yodel.io) offered valuable insights into the local startup scene, followed by an open Q&A with alumni.

With strong turnout and active engagement, the event strengthened local connections and set the tone for a year of meaningful community building across the EIT Alumni network.

BUDAPEST, 2 JULY 2024

In July, the EIT Alumni Community joined forces with the HEI Initiative to host a unique local event in Budapest, offering exclusive access to the ABCD Project Closing Conference. The day-long gathering explored the intersection of Generative AI and entrepreneurship, with hands-on workshops, expert talks, and opportunities for alumni to engage with local and regional innovation ecosystems.

Participants could choose from flexible attendance options — full day, afternoon sessions, or the evening FutureForge networking reception — ensuring broad accessibility for alumni with varying schedules.

Highlights included keynote speakers from European institutions, interactive workshops led by education and entrepreneurship experts, and vibrant community-building during the closing reception. The event strengthened ties between alumni, the Western Balkans innovation landscape, and the broader EIT ecosystem.

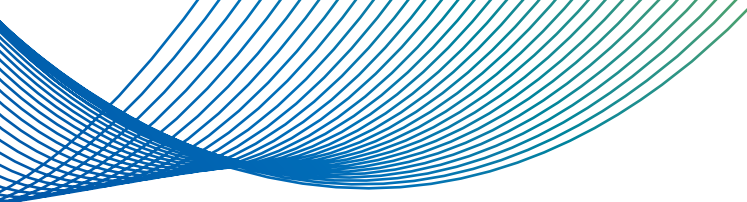

Annual Meeting in Málaga

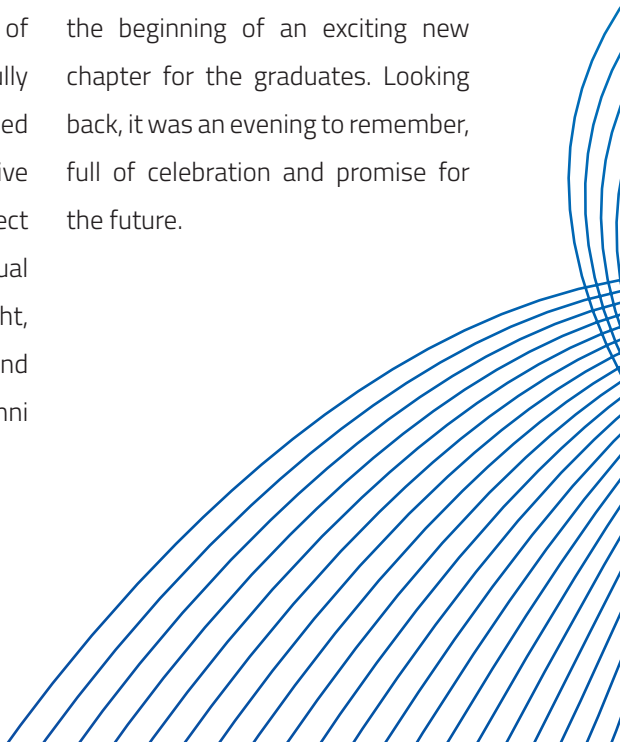

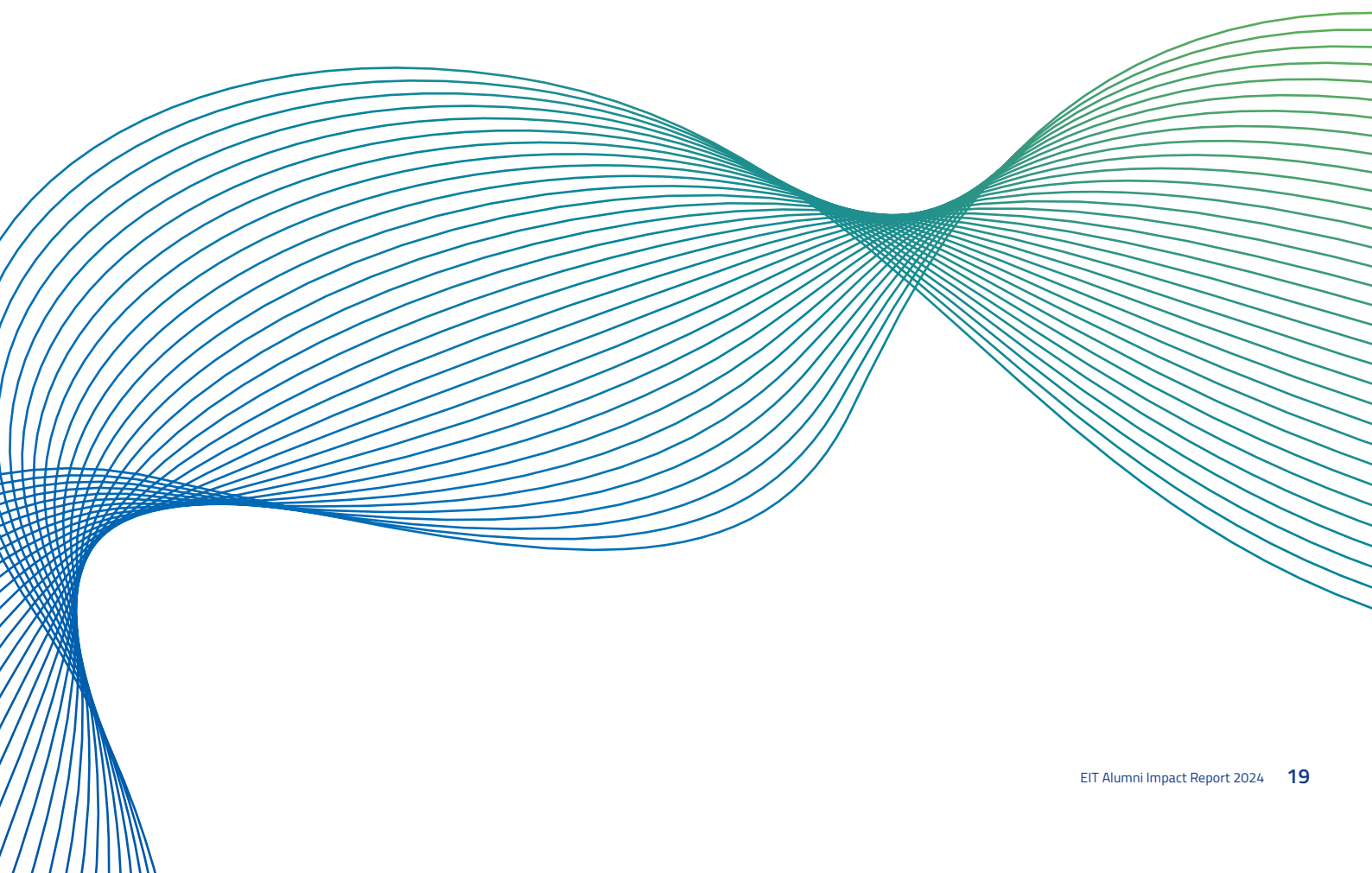




EIT RAWMATERIALS ALUMNI

EIT HEALTH INNOVATORS COMMUNITY

Green Transition Event, Alicante

For those attending EIT CONNECT in October, the Innovators Community offered a networking event focused on the challenge of achieving sustainable healthcare. There was a keynote address highlighting the need for greener health systems followed by an engaging panel discussion with innovators and experts exploring challenges and solutions in this area.

The scope of the event was broad, covering supply chain management, procurement, AI advances and workforce training. A lively networking lunch break and a dynamic, collaborative afternoon discussion ensured that members came away with actionable ideas and an amplified determination to drive the green transition in healthcare.

Launch of Scaling Scientific Start-ups Webinar Series

The 'Scaling Scientific Start-ups' webinar series launched as a collaboration between EIT Health Innovators Community and Creative Destruction Lab to support entrepreneurs and innovators looking to scale successfully. The series delivers practical advice and invaluable insights from experts on themes such as raising funding and running clinical research studies. Experts have shared learnings on issues around quality management systems, regulatory challenges and building a remote workforce. With a clear focus on growth and acceleration, these webinars equip researchers, innovators, investors and founders with the expertise and skillset to have a tangible impact in the healthcare industry.

Presence and Engagement at the EIT Health Summit and health.tech Munich

The Innovators Community was presented on the main stage of the EIT Health Summit, demonstrating the benefits and value of the network. A hands-on workshop led by Catherine Schreiber, who is now the EIT Alumni Board Chair followed, exploring how to manage organisational change, through culture, communication and leadership. A gamified approach taught participants to use insight, influence and planning to effectively promote change. The health.tech Munich event also shone a light on the Innovators Community with a prominent community member leading a session on scaling start-ups. This presentation provided perfect examples of the tangible successes and opportunities that arise from being an active member of the Innovators Community.

EIT FOOD ALUMNI

Food Hackathon

The “Hack the Future of Food” hackathon, held in Tartu, Estonia, on November 29-30, 2024, brought together students, researchers, and industry professionals to tackle sustainability challenges in the food and agriculture sectors. Over two days, participants used design thinking methods to develop innovative, real-world solutions for the food supply chain. Supported by EIT Food and local organizations, the event fostered collaboration and creativity, with the potential for new business solutions to emerge from the ideas pitched.

Launched in 2023, the EITL Manufacturing Alumni community focuses on growth, with 53 members and a goal of 70 by 2025. Key objectives include supporting EIT Manufacturing's mission and promoting women in manufacturing. The community is governed by a steering committee and collaborates with EITM staff. Communication is managed via LinkedIn, Agora, and newsletters. Challenges include reactivating engagement and selecting a new board in 2025. Despite limited funding, the community is committed to its goals and progress tracking.

EIT Welcome Events

The EIT InnoEnergy Welcome Events mark the exciting beginning of the academic year, with each location hosting its own gathering to welcome new students. These events offer new students a chance to connect with peers from various Masters+ programmes and become part of the vibrant EIT InnoEnergy CommUnity+. More than just a social occasion, the Welcome Events serve as a crucial introduction to the

wealth of opportunities available through Careers+ Services, equipping students with tools and resources to navigate their professional journeys. A key highlight of these events is the introduction to the EIT InnoEnergy Local Ecosystem. Representatives from portfolio companies and industry leaders are invited as guest speakers, sharing valuable insights into the energy sector and sparking engaging conversations.

By fostering connections and providing early access to career resources, the Welcome Events empower students to make the most of their EIT InnoEnergy journey, setting the stage for a rich academic experience and a thriving future in sustainable energy.

EIT InnoEnergy CommUnity+ & Schneider Electric Hackathon

The EIT InnoEnergy CommUnity+ & Schneider Electric Hackathon was a dynamic 9-hour event that brought together 40 students from diverse InnoEnergy Master programmes, showcasing innovation through collaboration.

The vibrant atmosphere fostered creativity and problem-solving, pushing students to embrace entrepreneurial thinking and produce tangible outcomes. More than a competition, the event

EIT SUMMIT 2024

We kicked off INNOVEIT with the 2024 EIT Summit, featuring a diverse lineup of inspiring, high-level speakers from the worlds of policy, business, and innovation. Attendees had the opportunity to explore some of the most cutting-edge technology and innovations emerging within the EIT Community, highlighted through the 2024 EIT Awards. A major highlight of the event was the first-ever announcement of the finalists for the EIT & EIC's joint European Prize for Women Innovators, marking a significant moment in recognizing female leadership in innovation. The summit was organized under the auspices of the Belgian Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

Additionally, industry leaders like Michał Dżoga from Intel and Mark Boris Andrijanič from Kumo. AI provided valuable perspectives on the role of deep tech in driving Europe's innovation agenda. This event highlighted the importance of collaboration between academia, corporations, and startups, emphasizing the EIT's role in fostering European competitiveness through transformative approaches in deep tech.

SLUSH

At the 2024 Slush event in Helsinki, the EIT Community showcased its commitment to fostering innovation and diversity. Kicking off on November 19, the INNOVEIT Conference highlighted the influence of women-led innovators and investors in shaping the future of deep tech. Entrepreneurs, investors, and industry leaders gathered to explore how diversity and technological advancements are driving tomorrow's tech landscape. On November 20-21, the EIT Community participated in SLUSH, where attendees were able to explore cutting-edge innovations at the EIT booth in Hall 6, Network with initiatives like the AI Community and Supernovas, and engage with representatives from various EIT Knowledge and Innovation Communities. It was a dynamic two-day event filled with presentations, networking opportunities, and insightful discussions on AI, deep tech, and sustainable innovation.



GREENTECH FESTIVAL IN BERLIN

At the 2024 Greentech Festival in Berlin, the EIT Community played a prominent role in driving the conversation around green innovation and sustainability. From May 15 to 17, the EIT brought together experts, entrepreneurs, and changemakers for the INNOVEIT conference, held on May 15, which focused on the theme "Road to Net Zero with Europe's Largest Innovation Ecosystem."

The event featured insightful keynote speeches, engaging panels, and networking sessions, offering valuable insights into the EIT's impact on green technology and the role it plays in advancing sustainability across Europe. Speakers from leading organizations, including Stefan Dobrev from Emmi Group and Maria Tsavachidis from EIT Urban Mobility, shared their expertise and perspectives.

The EIT Community also hosted side events, including a booth and a fireside chat, providing additional opportunities for attendees to explore the latest innovations and connect with like-minded individuals passionate about driving change in the green tech sector.

HIMSS

EIT Health participated in the HIMSS European Health Conference & Exhibition, held from May 29-31, 2024, at Centro Congressi Roma La Nuvola in Rome. The conference focused on pressing healthcare issues, including the impact of climate change, artificial intelligence, and health system resilience. As part of the event, EIT Health co-organized the Start-up Pitchfest on May 29th, where innovative

companies presented emerging solutions to address critical healthcare challenges. Marc Julien, Managing Director of EIT Health France, contributed as a speaker. Additionally, Jérôme Fabiano, Deputy Managing Director of EIT Health France, moderated a panel discussion on the governance, regulation, and validation of digital health technologies. The session explored evolving reimbursement

pathways across Europe, with updates on key initiatives such as the EDiHTA project, the Digital Medical Device taskforce (DiGa), and the French "Pecan" Early Access to Reimbursement program for digital medical devices.

EIT DEEP TECH TALENT INITIATIVE: DEEP TECH SKILLS DAYS

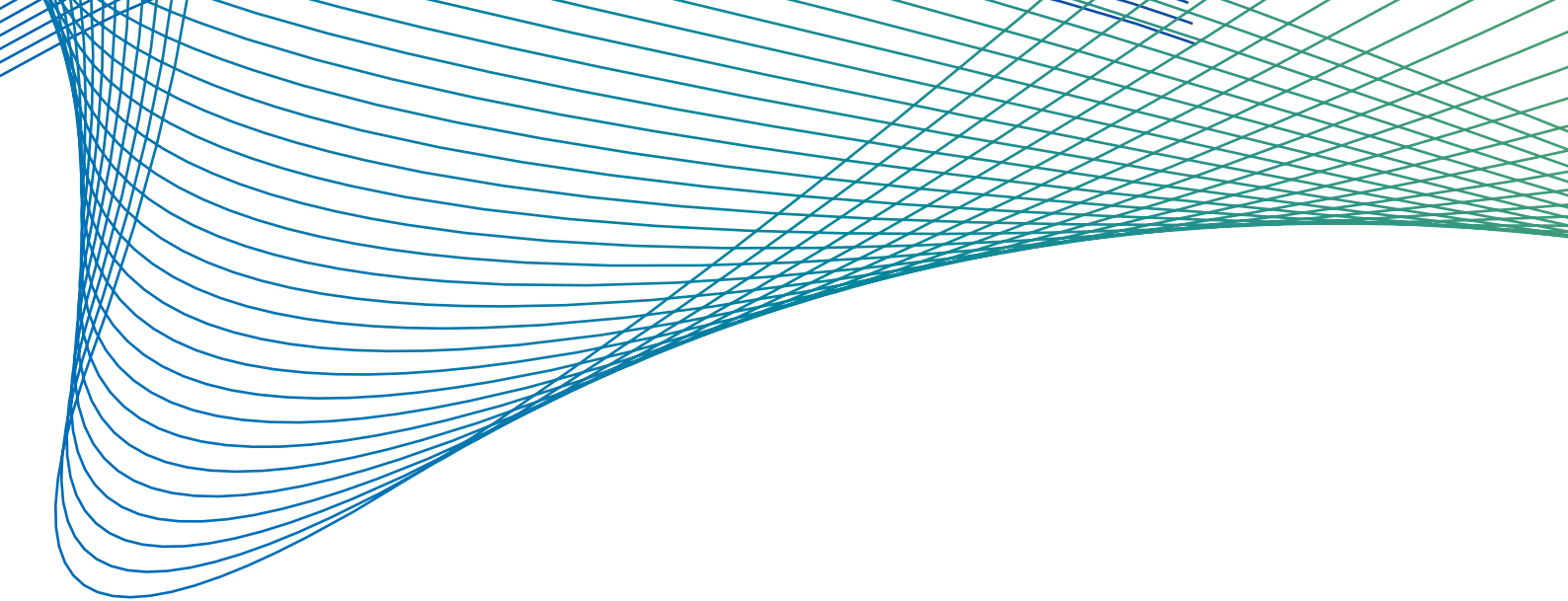
WOMEN AND GIRLS IN STEM FORUM 2024
